

KSA Transition Policy

This policy is to clarify the expectations and requirements of KSA students currently enrolled in HLT42812 Certificate IV in Kinesiology and HLT51507 Diploma of Kinesiology. The policy is based on the two General Directions issued by ASQA on January 1 2014 and April 1 2015. Students should clarify their enrolment date with their college to ensure they meet the requirements in the appropriate time frame.

Withdrawal of HLT42812 Certificate IV in Kinesiology as at 1st August 2015

KSA will provide all Cert IV students the opportunity to complete their Cert IV in the contracted time frame. An extension can be granted to a maximum of two years. After the two years all remaining Certificate IV students must be transitioned into the new diploma. The final date to transition Cert IV students is **1 August 2017**

Superseded HLT51507 Diploma Kinesiology as at 1st August 2015

Students enrolled in the HLT51507 Diploma after June 2014 and prior to 1 April 2015 will have the opportunity to complete their Cert IV in the contracted time frame. An extension can be granted to a maximum of 18 months to complete their diploma or they must be transitioned into the new HLT52415 Diploma. The last date for transitioning students will be **1st Feb 2017**.

Students enrolled in the HLT51507 Diploma before June 2014 must contact their campus administration and apply for an extension. An extension can be received for up to 12 months after 1st August 2015 or they must be transitioned into the new HLT52415 Diploma. An extension fee may apply. The last date for transitioning students will be **1st August 2016**.

Below are two spreadsheets outlining KSA's workshops and homestudy units and how they can be transitioned to the new Diploma qualification.
